We are sorry to report that Senator Ed Werbowski 4672 died in Winnipeg on August 27. Ed was a charter member of the Yorkton Jaycees and a former Provincial Secretary. He played an integral part in helping the Yorkton Jaycees to win the "World's Outstanding Unit" award. Seven Senators attended a packed house memorial service, including his good friends from the Yorkton days Senator Kenneth Dodds 5724 and Senator Lorne Harason 4673 who delivered the eulogy.

On a happier note, the Winnipeg Free Press published a half page article highlighting the 20 day, 610 kilometer *solo* canoe journey down the rapid-filled Hayes river from Lake Winnipeg to Hudson's Bay by Senator Ivan Holloway 68419. En Route he had to shoot a bear in self defense. He carried a satellite message service. He punched a button twice a day that conveyed his location to people on a subscription list. Another button, which he didn't have to use, sent his location directly to Manitoba Search and Rescue. He was probably relieved to get back to his relatively safer life as a litigation lawyer.
