Convincing Frieda that we should join was no problem. I attended the next meeting. Harold Chapman 2951 was President and John Hahn 5718 sponsored me. I became involved in the leadership opportunity programmes. One of my first fun projects was the Dynamo, which was the Newsletter of Kitchener-Waterloo Jaycees. It won a national award which spurred me on to tackle even more. The public speaking course was a big help to me. The Central Ontario Exhibition in Kitchener-Waterloo required almost full membership involvement with every action giving leadership co-operation training. I was saddened by the passing of Joyce Clark 2816. It was my fortunate experience to have worked with Joyce during the 1950's at the National Jaycee Headquarters in Montreal. Joyce worked for a number of the Executive Directors during that period including Donald C Carlisle 201, Harold Bibby 536 and myself. I think we all felt she was much more qualified for the staff position than we were, but in those days the Jaycees were strictly an all-male organization. With almost 20,000 members (including the Quebec La Federation) and with a small office staff she kept the wheels turning.
