I think my job at this juncture is now to encourage all Senators to consider attending the Crew Meeting in Prince George, BC. In my last report I said ..... "The Prince George committee has decided that there will be a full day (the Friday) devoted to being in Barkerville, BC. This is a restored gold rush ghost town and is on the bucket list for many. In our organization we do not formalize membership and many Senators in Canada do not support the Canadian Senate by way of a contribution from time to time and choose to be on a dormant list. My question is, which Senators would be eligible to release a proxy vote?

I would certainly hope not someone who has willing placed themselves on the dormant list. I would also hope it would not be a Senator that has no real expectation of involvement or interest in Canada JCI activities. So, I think we have to be careful on this matter because I think, one Crew Meeting that was over weighted with proxies from Senators that have no real involvement in the Canada JCI Senate would be very detrimental. In speaking with our Secretary Treasurer Barney, he would need the proxy owner to declare the proxy holder in advance of the Crew Meeting as he would have no ability to verify anything at the Crew Meeting itself.

I now live on a 50 acre farm with five horses (that's all I can handle from the window). We have a pre-nuptial agreement with one sentence: "Doug does not have to go near the horses".

Kim really looks after me. I am eating everything in sight that is organic. I am on the stationary bike most mornings for 20 minutes.
