President's Message

Greetings fellow Senators! I am honored to have been elected your president at the Meeting of the Crew in Ajax!

I realized during the Crew Meeting that there were some synergies around my election of which I was previously unaware. This is the 41st year of the Canada Senate and it is also my 41st anniversary of joining the North Calgary Jaycees. I was among the first women to be welcomed into the organization in Canada and now I am the first woman President of the Senate. Maybe it was meant to be.

In addition to the election there was a bid by the Calgary JCI Senate to host the Meeting of the Crew in Calgary in September of 2015 along with the JCI Canada National Convention. The bid was defeated and while there was some controversy about the vote, I feel bound by the decision of the delegates and will be looking for Senate groups in the West to host the Crew Meeting in April/May of 2015. If you are interested please contact me ASAP.

It is also my hope that there will be a Senate Program at the JCI National Convention in Calgary in September and I for one will be there with bells on. (*Don't worry I am not actually going to wear bells*). I know there are a lot of you who are in close proximity and it would be a great chance for us to show up and work together with JCI members to forge a new relationship to benefit all. I especially encourage Senators who don't normally attend the Meeting of the Crew to come out and experience a different sort of gathering that may be more your style.

It is a privilege to work with these fine Senators who generously donate their time. Thank you all, I know we will have a great year.

Prior to the election I presented a motion for the formation of a New Directions committee to be formed. Here are the details of that motion:

Background

The Canada JCI Senate is forty years old this year; it was established in 1974 under the direction of Harry Weldon 5881. Over the years strong leadership from the Executive and the tireless efforts of our Secretary Treasurer Barney C Ziola, has built an amazing organization.

The Road Ahead

As the Senate moves into its fifth decade, I believe it is a time for reflection and a review of the organization's governance. We are not getting any younger and with less and less Canadian Senatorships being awarded, the membership is slowly decreasing. Conservative projections indicate that the membership will decline to half its current size by the end of this decade.

Thanks to sound fiscal management by the Executives over many years, the Senate is in an excellent financial position. However, this last year the organization suffered a loss on its operations for the first time. This is the beginning of a steadily decreasing revenue stream and these needs to be addressed.

We are also not attracting the younger Senators and this is a big concern. I believe it is time to set up a New Directions Committee that will meet over the next year and report at the 2015 Annual Meeting of the Canada JCI Senate.

The Concept

The incoming Executive is to be tasked with setting up a New Directions Committee. The membership of the committee shall consist of the following:

- One elected member from the 2014-2015 Executive
- Two members of the Canada JCI Senate who have not previously served on the Executive.
- One Past President of JCI Canada
- The Secretary-Treasurer of the Canada JCI Senate as an ex-officio member

Terms of Reference

The terms of reference for the New Directions committee shall be as follows:

- To develop ways and means of increasing the involvement of the younger members of the Canada JCI Senate in the organization.
- To review ways and means of assisting JCI Canada.
- To review the relationship between the Canada JCI Senate and JCI Canada
- To review the operations of the Canada JCI Senate and make recommendations as to what changes need to be made to the financing of the organization, as the income of the Canada JCI Senate slowly decreases in the coming years.
- To review the annual Meeting of the Crew and make recommendations on what changes need to be made due to the decreasing income in the coming years.
- To recommend a proxy voting system, so that each member has a voice in the running of the Canada JCI Senate.
- To report on the committee's findings at the 2015 annual meeting of the Canada JCI Senate.

Note: Items 1, 2, and 3 shall be dealt with between the committee and the executive of JCI Canada, or a committee to be appointed by them. They shall report their recommendations to both bodies.

Summary

The efforts of the New Directions committee should provide a road map that will improve our governance and shape the direction of the Canada JCI Senate as it moves into its fifth decade.

Over the next few weeks I will put together the committee and set up a schedule for meetings. I hope that you will all embrace the future of our great organization and that you will contribute to that future in whatever way works for you.

Thank you for this opportunity to serve as your President. I will endeavour to represent you well.

On June 5, 2012 I received an honorary Doctor of Laws degree from the University of Alberta. Chancellor Ralph Young said:

"Over a pioneering journalism career spanning 15,000 TV and radio editorials of 47 years, seven cities and five provinces, Bruce Hogle has consistently sought to initiate changes to benefit both his profession and his community. In his 31 years at CFRN TV/CTV Edmonton, he hosted Canada's first public affairs show "*Face the Newsmen*". His TV documentary "*What About the Victim*" saw Alberta establish Canada's first Crimes Compensation Board. As inaugural chair of Grant MacEwen College's Journalism Advisory Committee, he helped establish their first curriculum. He also produced Canada's first 30-minute teaching video on journalism which he shared at no cost to all Canadian journalism schools, National Archives of Canada, Carleton Board of Education and smaller TV news operations.

"Mr. Hogle persuaded the Alberta Government to become first in the Commonwealth to allow live coverage of legislature deliberations. In 1981, he launched the visionary "*Wednesday's Child*" now in its 33rd year of helping difficult-to-adopt children find permanent homes. Encouraged by his involvement in over 30 charities and not-for-profit organizations in Edmonton, Alberta and across Canada, in 1993, Mr. Hogle established the "*CFRN TV Good Neighbor Fund*" – a program that continues to assist needy Albertans.

For his work within the communications field and various communities, he has been named a member of the Order of Canada; received the Alberta Order of Excellence; celebrated as one of the 100 Edmontonians of the Century in 2004; inducted into the Canadian Association of Broadcasters Hall of Fame; received the Radio Television News Directors Association Lifetime Achievement Award; named a Paul Harris Fellow by Rotary International; and named a Melvin Jones

Fellow by Lions International. Mr. Hogle's living legacy of community service and high journalistic standards reflects an inspiring balance of integrity, compassion and conviction."
