Senator Lloyd Stockdale 20377 shared with me a 2013 letter written by five Past Presidents of JCI. In it, they note that with no women, no chapters in communist countries or Muslim countries of the Middle East, the membership of JCI in 1978 stood at 568,684 in 12,395 chapters. In 2013 those numbers were 168,390 members in 4734 chapters.

They went on to blame the fact that JCI was no longer run by the 'young', but by advisors, alumni and other overage individuals. They called upon everyone over the age of 40, to resign their office, or their staff post. I wish I knew what happened next. Can anyone advise me if this is the situation in Canada too? If so, does this contribute to the decline in numbers any more than "the young are too busy pursuing careers, to join JCI"?
